1. Brief Introduction (Not more than 100 words)

Set up by UGC, Govt. of India in 1987 as the Academic Staff College, it was re-christened in 2015 as UGC Human Resource Development Centre and has now been upgraded to UGC Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre. It is entrusted with in-service professional development initiatives: FIP (Faculty Induction Programme, Subject Refresher Courses, Interaction Programmes and other skill development programmes) for the newly appointed Assistant Professors, other academic staff, non-teaching staff and research scholars across the country.

Since 2015 the Centre has been serving as the Nodal Agency for the HRD Ministry's NRC (Urdu) and ARPIT on SWAYAM platform (Education). CALEM programmes under the PMMMNMTT Scheme have also been conducted. It organized in 2019 and 2020 the prestigious LEAP programmes for Senior Professors across the country, in Ohio State University, USA and Monash University, Melbourne, Australia respectively.

Also as part of its MoU with RELO, US Embassy, New Delhi, it has delivered between 2007 to 2022 the English Proficiency Access Programme for the AMU School students. Over the years it has organized mentoring programme for Fulbright Language Teaching Assistant Scholarships for the AMU students. So far more than one dozen AMU students have joined as FLTA in various US Universities.

Since its inception in 1987 the UGC-ASC/HRDC/MMTTC, AMU has organized a total number of 156 Orientation Programmes, 23 Online Faculty Induction Programmes, 02 Hybrid/Offline/Residential Faculty Induction Programmes and 465 Refresher Courses and benefitted a total No. of 5366, 4359 and 19963 course participants respectively. Apart from this thousands of research scholars, school teachers and administrative staff members have benefitted from various Short-Term Courses and other training programmes.
